Reading Eggs-your child should have a login (same as logging on to school computer)

Storyline Online-celebrities read books online and there are questions about the book too.

Pobble 365- writing picture prompts with questions, grammar activities etc about the picture

ABC Ya- English and maths games, click on your child's year level

Prodigy- if they don't remember their login, you can create a new account easily

IXL maths- interactive and free for about 10 sums
